

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute an Amendment to the Agreement with the Ky. Transportation Cabinet, for the acceptance of additional Federal funds in the amount of \$22,200 for the design of Town Branch Trail Crossing under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government for the expenditure of an additional \$5,550 as a local match. Authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement between the LFUCG and the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for additional federal funds in the amount \$22,200 for design of Town Branch Trail Crossing at Old Frankfort Pike and McConnell Springs Drive under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program.
