NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That Richard Young, Barbara Jane Sutherland, and William H. Wilson be and hereby are appointed as Reapportionment Commissioners to serve along with Susan Lamb, Fayette County Clerk, who will be a non-voting member of the Reapportionment Commission.

Section 2 - That the Reapportionment Commission be and hereby is directed to lay off the district boundaries of the districts of the three (3) Fiscal Court Commissioners; three (3) Justices of the Peace (Magistrates); and three (3) Constables, pursuant to KRS 67.045.

Section 3 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$200.00 each, be and hereby is approved for payment to Richard Young, Barbara Jane Sutherland, and William H. Wilson from

account # 1101-112007-0001-71299 for their services as Reapportionment Commissioners.

Section 4 - That the Clerk of the Urban County Council be and hereby is directed to publish notice of the reapportionment proceedings as required by law.

Section 5 - That this Resolution shall become effective upon its passage.
