A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Energy and Environmental Cabinet-Div. of Waste Management, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$110,000 Commonwealth of Ky. funds, are for the Fayette County Household Hazardous Waste Recycling Event, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government for the expenditure of a 25% local match in the amount of \$28,007, which will be provided from documentation of employee wages, volunteers and program advertising, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant budget. A 25% local match is required and will come from documentation of employee wages, volunteers, and program advertising. The total project cost will be \$138,007. GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a grant from the Kentucky Energy and

Environmental Cabinet-division of Waste Management, which Grant funds are in the amount of

\$110,000.00 Commonwealth of Kentucky funds, are for the Fayette County Household Hazardous

Waste Recycling Event, and the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government for the expenditure of a 25% local match in the amount of \$28,007.00, which will be

provided from documentation of employee wages, volunteers and program advertising.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby

authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer

the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or

capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
