WHEREAS, at a Public Hearing held on April 28, 2016 a petition for a zoning ordinance map amendment for property located at 256 & 260 Lexington Avenue from a High Density Apartment (R-4) zone to a High Rise Apartment (R-5) zone for 0.59 net (0.69 gross) acre, including dimensional variances, was presented to the Urban County Planning Commission; said Commission recommending approval of the zone change by a vote of 9-0; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE

URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Zoning Ordinance of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government

be amended to show a change in zone for property located at 256 & 260 Lexington Avenue from a

High Density Apartment (R-4) zone to a High Rise Apartment (R-5) zone for 0.59 net (0.69 gross)

acre, being more fully described in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by

reference.

Section 2 - That the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Planning Commission is directed to

show the amendment on the official zone map atlas and to make reference to the number of this

Ordinance.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
