A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute an Agreement with Christopher Van Brackel, for care of and retirement of the canine Elvis. [Div. of Police, Barnard]

Authorization to enter into a Release of Claims Against the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) Agreement. This agreement will allow the Lexington Police Department to release retired Canine Elvis to Lieutenant Christopher Van Brackel. The attached agreement will release and forever discharge the LFUCG, and its agents and successors, of and from any all manner of actions, claims and demands whatsoever arising out of the gift of the retired police canine. In return, Lieutenant Van Brackel acknowledges that this agreement will preclude him from utilizing the retired police canine in an "off-duty" employment assignment for security or law enforcement purposes, and is prohibited to sale or transfer the retired police canine to another public safety entity.
