Section 1 - That the following subsection line number in the classified civil service authorized strength be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 2 - That the incumbents be and hereby are transferred from exempt positions to non-exempt positions as follows:

William Snyder, from Project Manager Sr., Grade 519E, at \$2,192.48 biweekly, to Project Manager Sr., Grade 519N, at \$27.406 hourly;

William Osborne, from Project Manager Sr., Grade 519E, at \$2,093.28 biweekly, to Project Manager Sr., Grade 519N, at \$26.166 hourly;

Section 3 - That this Ordinance shall become effective the first payroll Monday following passage of Council.
