Authorization to execute Agreement with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), Tactical Diversion Task Force Agreement. The term of this Agreement shall be from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017. The Tactical Diversion Task Force Agreement allows for one (1) Lexington Division of Police Officer to be assigned to this task force for a period of not less than two years. During this period of assignment, the officer will be under the direct supervision and control of a DEA Supervisory Special Agent assigned to the Task Force. No Budgetary impact.
