BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Council of Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government does hereby approve and adopt substantial amendments to the 2015, 2016 and 2017 Annual Action Plans, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, decreasing funds for the Single Family Housing Rehabilitation Program (\$247,689.05) and reallocating those funds to the Meadows - Northland - Arlington Public Facilities Project (\$247,689.05).

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget established herein.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
