A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Dept. of Military Affairs, Div. of Emergency Management, which Grant Funds are in the amount of \$106,212.27 Federal funds, for the FY2016 Emergency Management Assistance Project, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$106,212.27 as a local match, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant budget. Authorization to accept award in the amount of \$106,212.27 from Kentucky Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management for FY 2016 Emergency Management Assistance Project. The purpose of this project is to support emergency preparedness activities in Fayette County. Funds are used to offset personnel and operating costs in the Division of Emergency Management/911. The source of federal funds is the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency. A match of \$106,212,27 has been Budgeted. A Budget amendment is in process for the award.
