A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Office of Homeland Security, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$300,000 Federal funds, under the 2018 State Homeland Security Grant Program, are for the purchase of a Critical Incident Tactical Intervention Vehicle for the Emergency Response Unit for the Div. of Police, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. [Div. of Police, Weathers]

Authorization to accept award of Federal funds in the amount of \$300,000 from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security for the purchase of a Critical Incident Tactical Intervention Vehicle for the Emergency Response Unit in the Division of Police under the 2018 State Homeland Security Grant Program. Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby

authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer

the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or

capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
