Household Hazardous Waste Management Grant Program and to provide any additional information requested in connection with this Grant Application, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$110,000 Commonwealth of Ky. funds, and are for the Fayette County Household Hazardous Waste Recycling Event. Authorization to submit application under the Household Hazardous Waste Grant from the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet/Division of Waste Management. These funds will be used to support a one-day hazardous household waste disposal event. The amount of state funds is \$110,000. A local match of \$28,007.42 is required.
