Sprinkler Contracting Association in the amount of \$2,000 and Skyzone Lexington in the amount of \$500, for use at the Div. of Fire and Emergency Services, Community Services Bureau, to pay for wrapping Community Services vehicles to promote home and fire safety messages and contact information, at no cost to the Urban County Government.
