A Resolution approving and adopting substantial amendments to the 2019 Annual Action plan decreasing funds for the RHISE Rent Assistance Program (\$191,803.33) and Bluegrass Community Action Partnership Elder Nutrition Program (\$60,000.00) and reallocating those funds to the Lexington Housing Authority (\$251,803.33), and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Authorization to approve and adopt a substantial amendment to the 2019 Annual Action Plan to move funding from one CARES Act Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV) project to another resulting in a net zero change. Unspent funds in the amount of \$251,662.08 from the RHISE rent assistance program will be reallocated to the Lexington Housing Authority to support Emergency Housing Vouchers. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Council of Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government does hereby approve and adopt a substantial amendment to the 2019 Annual Action Plan, which is attached

hereto and incorporated herein by reference, decreasing funds for the RHISE rent assistance program (\$191,803.33) and reallocating those funds to the Lexington Housing Authority (\$251,803.33).

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget established herein.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
