BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement, which is attached hereto and

Section 2 - That an amount, estimated not to exceed the sum of \$110,828.50, be and hereby is approved for payment to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, for the use and benefit of the University of Kentucky, from account #4003 - 303408 - 92811, pursuant to the terms of the agreement.
