A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Dept. of Juvenile Justice, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$20,000 Federal funds, under the Title II Program, are for the operation of the "No Limit to Success" Program, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$5,040 as a local match, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Authorization to accept a Grant from the Kentucky Department of Juvenile Justice, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$20,000 Federal funds, under the Title II Program, to operate the "No Limit to Success Program" in the Division of Youth Services. Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a Grant from the Kentucky Department of Juvenile Justice, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$20,000 Federal Funds, under the Title II Program, are for the operation of the "No Limit to Success" Program, the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$5,040 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
