A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute Amendment No. 2 to the Grant Agreement with the Ky. Transportation Cabinet, to extend the Grant through June 30, 2021, and to accept additional Grant funds in the amount of \$48,400 in Federal funds, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government to the expenditure of \$12,100 as a local match, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to execute Amendment No. 2 to the Grant Agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, to extend the Grant through June 30, 2021 and to accept additional Grant funds in the amount of \$48,400 in Federal funds, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government to the expenditure of \$12,100.00 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
