## **Legislation Text**

A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Fire Commission, which Grant Funds are in the amount of \$7,750 Commonwealth of Ky. Funds, are for purchase of a forcible door entry training prop, and does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant budget. Authorization to accept award of state funds in the amount of \$7,750 from the Kentucky Fire Commission for purchase of a forcible door entry training prop for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services. The proper contains a variety of door security systems in use and can be rigged to simulate non-standard systems. No matching funds are required. A budget amendment is in process. Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby

authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer

the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or

capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
