A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute a Subrecipient Agreement with NAMI Lexington (Ky), Inc., for the operation of the Fayette Mental Health Court, at a cost not to exceed \$170,000, using funds awarded under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), and authorizing the Mayor to execute any other needed Agreements or amendments with NAMI Lexington (Ky), Inc., related to the use of these funds.
