Authorization to engage OpenGov for services for Analytical Software not to exceed \$19,500 for a one year subscription. This software will provide a platform for developing internal management tools and reports which will facilitate the analysis of historical, current and future financial trends presenting management and Council with additional information to include in the decision making process.
