A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, to accept an award for the Fire Training Incentive Grant from the Commission on Fire Protection, Personnel, Standards, and Education, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$4,059,254 in Commonwealth of Ky. funds, for Fire Training Incentives for Firefighters for FY 2025, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept an award for the Fire Training Incentive Grant from the

Commission on Fire Protection, Personnel, Standards, and Education, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$4,059,254.00 in Commonwealth of Kentucky funds, for Fire training incentives for Firefighters for FY 2025, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Section 7-48 of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Code of Ordinances, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
