A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an Agreement with the Cabinet for Health and Family Services accepting an additional \$75,150 in Federal funds for the Ky. Opioid Response Effort, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds, authorizing the Mayor to execute any necessary amendments related to the use of these funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds with the Grant Budget established for this Grant. GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to execute an Agreement with the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to accept an additional \$75,150.00 in Federal funds for the Kentucky Opioid Response Effort, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute any necessary amendments to the Agreement with Cabinet for Health and Family Services related to the use of these funds.

Section 3 -- That subject to the provisions of Section 7-48 of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Code of Ordinances, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 4 -- That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
