[Div. of Police, Weathers]

Authorization to accept the End User License Agreement and Quotation(s) for purchase of software with Magnet Forensics, LLC, a Sole Source Vendor for Axiom and DVR Examiner Software. Magnet AXIOM is a digital investigative platform for recovering digital evidence. DVR Examiner is a software tool used in forensic investigations to recover video and metadata from digital video recorders (DVRs). This Agreement is effective September 1, 2024, through August 31, 2025, for a cost of \$18,150. Funds are Budgeted. (L0722-24) (Weathers/Armstrong)
