A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute an Agreement with Ky. Housing Corp., for purposes of establishing the Office of Homelessness Prevention and Intervention's role, responsibility, and utilization of the Ky. Homeless Management Information System (Ky-HMIS), at a cost not to exceed \$11,628 for FY 16. [Office of Homelessness Prevention and Intervention, Lanter]

Authorization to execute an Agreement with Kentucky Housing Corporation that specifies the roles and responsibilities of KHC and the Office of Homelessness Prevention & Intervention for purposes of operating the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) database. This Agreement designates KHC as the HMIS "lead" and access provider for the system. The cost for this Fiscal Year is \$11,628.00. (L0533-16) (Lanter/Hamilton)

Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$11,628.00 for FY 16, be and hereby is approved for payment to Kentucky Housing Corporation, from account # 1145-155003-78112, pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
