A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Bicycle and Bikeway Commission's Paula Nye Memorial Bicyclist and Pedestrian Education Program, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$10,000 Commonwealth of Ky. funds, and are for the operation of a Bike and Pedestrian Public Education Program, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant budget. Authorization to accept a grant in the amount of \$10,000 from the Kentucky Bicycle and Bikeway Commission's Paula Nye Memorial Bicyclist and Pedestrian Education Program for operation of a public education program for bike and pedestrian safety. A grant application submission was previously approved by council on September 25, 2015 (Resolution #593-2015). A budget amendment is in process. (L1499-15)(Gooding/Paulsen)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY

GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a grant from the Kentucky Bicycle and Bikeway File #: 1499-15, Version: 1

Commission's Paula Nye Memorial Bicyclist and Pedestrian Education Program, which Grant funds

are in the amount of \$10,000.00 Commonwealth of Kentucky funds, and are for the operation of a

bike and pedestrian public education program, the acceptance of which does not obligate the

Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby

authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer

the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or

capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
