The Downtown Lexington Management District shall Grant, convey, and transfer all its rights and obligations to the plaque to Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, and Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government shall accept all such rights and obligations, including but not limited to providing insurance coverage and maintenance of the plaque. not limited to providing insurance coverage and maintenance of the plaque.
