Request Council authorization to execute Change Order #1 in the amount of \$31,483.33 to the contract with Randle-Davies Construction Co., LLC for resurfacing, color coat and striping of two (2) existing tennis courts to create six (6) pickleball courts at Kirklevington Park. The Change Order for bid #38-2015 is fully funded and the new contract amount, including this change order, will be \$81,363.33.
