A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$2,349,227 Commonwealth of Ky. funds, are for police training incentive funds, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant budget. Authorization to accept award for Police Training Incentive Grant in an amount up to \$2,349,227 for FY 2016 From The Kentucky Justice And Public Safety Cabinet Under The Kentucky Law Enforcement Foundation Program Fund. This amount is made up of supplemental pay totaling \$1,767,000 and pension contributions totaling \$582,227. No local match is required. A budget amendment is in process. (L0649-15)(Gooding/Bastin)

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby

authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer

the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or

capital account appropriation within the Grant budget established herein.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
