An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by abolishing one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Staff Assistant Sr., Grade 510N, and creating one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Permit Clerk, Grade 512N in the Div. of Police, and reclassifying the incumbent, effective upon passage of Council. [Div. of Human Resources, Maxwell]

Authorization to abolish one (1) classified position of Staff Assistant Sr. (Grade 510N) and create one (1) classified position of Permit Clerk (Grade 512N); reclassifying the incumbent within the Division of Police, effective upon passage of Council. This has a 12-month future impact of a cost of \$4,105.70. Funds are Budgeted. (L0311-16) (Maxwell/Hamilton)
