A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute and submit a Grant Application to the Ky. Dept. for Local Government and to provide any additional information requested in connection with this Grant Application, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$73,450 Federal funds, and are for upgrades for the Masterson Station Playground to become ADA compliant, the acceptance of which requires 50% local match. [Div. of Grants and Special Programs/Div. of General Services, Gooding/Reed]

Authorization to submit an application to the Kentucky Department for Local Government requesting federal funds in the amount of \$73,450 from the FY 2015 Land and Water Conservation Fund for upgrading the Masterson Station Playground to be compliant with the updated Americans with Disabilities Act. If awarded, the project requires a 50% local match of \$73,450 which is being requested in the FY16 budget. The total project cost is \$149,900. (L0390-15)(Gooding/Reed)
