Authorization of the Final Environmental Covenant associated with the Newtown Pike Extension Project - Mitigation Area. This Environmental Covenant is consistent with the Environmental Impact Statement (FHWA-KY-EIS-0301-F) filed in June 2007 for the Project. This action is required and is part of the acceptance, transfer and use of the land within the Mitigation Area. The Environmental Covenant ensures future awareness and protection of elevated contaminants contained in the deeper soils on the property purchased within the Mitigation Area. No Budgetary impact.
