A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute a Subrecipient Agreement with Community Action Council ("CAC") in order to allocate \$1,400,000 of Federal Grant funds awarded pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 to the CAC for the provision of temporary non-congregate emergency shelter and case management services, and authorizing the Mayor to execute any other needed Agreements or Amendments with the CAC related to the use of these funds. [Div. of Grants and Special Programs, Lanter] Authorization to execute an American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 subrecipient Agreement with Community Action Council to provide temporary non-congregate emergency shelter during the winter months, November 1, 2021 until April 30, 2022 for households experiencing unsheltered homelessness and unable to enter a congregate emergency shelter at a cost not to exceed \$1,400,000.00.
