A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept an award from the Bluegrass Area Development District, Inc., of \$7,552.62 in Federal funds under the American Rescue Plan Act for the Lexington Senior Citizens Center, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds, authorizing the Mayor to execute any necessary Agreements related to these funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Authorization to accept federal American Rescue Plan Act Title IIIB funds in the amount of \$7,552.62 from the Bluegrass Area Development District (BGADD) for the Lexington Senior Citizens Center to purchase equipment to improve the listening experience for participants who use hearing aids. Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 97-21, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
