A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute an Agreement to accept a Grant of \$23,600 from the Trust for Public Land, through On Common Ground: activating community connections through parks, for the Div. of Parks and Recreation, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. [Div. of Parks and Recreation, Conrad]

Authorization to accept Grant funds of \$23,600 from Trust for Public Land: On Common Ground: Activating Community Connections through Parks Programs for the Division of Parks and Recreation to support Programs that promote contact and engagement between people from different social groups. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute an Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein

by reference, to accept a Grant of \$23,600 from the Trust for Public Land, through On Common Ground: Activating Community Connections through Parks, for the Division of Parks and Recreation, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Section 7-48 of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Code of Ordinances, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
