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A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with Ky. River Watershed Watch, to provide services relating to water quality monitoring in the South Elkhorn Watershed, at a cost not to exceed \$5,000. [Div. of Water Quality, Martin]

Authorization to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with Kentucky River Watershed Watch to coordinate volunteers to provide water quality monitoring in the South Elkhorn Watershed in the fall of 2017 and the summer of 2018. The monitoring fulfills a component of LFUCG's Watershed-Focused Monitoring Program (WFMP) which is a requirement of the city's Kentucky Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (KDPES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit. The cost for FY18 is \$5,000.00. Funds are Budgeted. (L0660-17) (Martin/Hoskins-Squier)
