A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the William R. Kenan, Jr. Charitable Trust, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$700,000, are for the planning and design of the COACH (Civic Outreach, Advocacy, and Cooperative Hiring) Fellowship for young African-American males, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Authorization to accept award of \$700,000 from the William R. Kenan, Jr. Charitable Trust, for the planning and design of a civic fellowship for young African - American males. The COACH Fellowship (Civic Outreach, Advocacy, and Cooperative Hiring) initiative is built upon a partnership with Louisville Metro (THRIVE Fellowship); and Cities United, a national nonprofit organization committed to reducing violence. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY
GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a Grant from the William R. Kenan, Jr. Charitable Trust, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$700,000.00, are for the planning and design of the COACH (Civic, Outreach, Advocacy, and Cooperative Hiring) Fellowship for young African-American males, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
