A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Commonwealth of Ky. Transportation Cabinet Div. of Highway Safety Programs, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$30,000 Federal funds, are for Distracted Driving Enforcement Services, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant budget. [Div. of Grants and Special Programs/Dept. of Public Safety, Gooding/Bastin]

Authorization to accept award in the amount of \$30,000 from the Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Division of Highway Safety Programs for Distracted Driving Enforcement Services. The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's Division of Highway Safety Programs has offered the LFUCG federal funds for a distracted driving enforcement program. The funds will be used to support officer overtime between September 21, 2015 and October 30, 2015. No match is required. A budget amendment is in process. (L1151-15)(Gooding/Bastin)

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a grant from the Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Division of Highway Safety Programs, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$30,000.00 Federal funds, are for Distracted Driving Enforcement Services, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
