An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by creating ten (10) Classified Civil Service Positions of Safety Officer, Grade 511N; reallocating two (2) Classified Civil Service Positions of Safety Officer, Grade 510N and the authorized incumbents, all in the Division of Police, effective upon passage of Council. [Div. of Human Resources, Maxwell]

Authorization to create ten (10) classified positions of Safety Officer (Grade 511N) and reallocate two (2) classified positions of Safety Officer (Grade 510N to Grade 511N) and the incumbents in the Division of Police, effective upon passage by Council. Upon the request of the division, and in accordance with Section 21-2 (d) of the Code of Ordinances, the Division of Human Resources conducted a classification study on the position of Safety Officers. As a result, a recommendation for their requested positions as described in this action. To illustrate, this has a 12-month future impact of a cost of \$442,183.37. There is a budget amendment in process for this action. (L1484-15) (Maxwell/Bastin)
