A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the United States Dept. of Health and Human Services, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$508,928 in Federal funds, under the First Responders - Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act Program Year 3 Continuation Grant, and are to be used to help reduce Opioid Overdose Fatalities, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Authorization to accept a federal Year 3 Continuation Grant in the amount of \$508,928 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services under the First Responders - Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act Program which will be used to reduce the number of overdose fatalities by facilitating access to naloxone through first responders and members of other key community sectors. Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a grant from the United States Department of Health

and Human Services, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$508,928.00 in Federal funds, under

the First Responders - Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act Program Year 3 Continuation

Grant, and are to be used to help reduce Opioid Overdose Fatalities, the acceptance of which does

not obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby

authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer

the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or

capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
