A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the U.S. Dept. of Justice, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$42,100 Federal funds, under the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) for the reimbursement of costs related to the incarceration of undocumented criminal aliens, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant budget. [Div. of Grants and Special Programs/Dept. of Public Safety, Gooding/Bastin]

Authorization to accept award from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$42,100 under the 2015 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program. The State Criminal Alien Assistance Program provides funds to States and localities as reimbursement for costs of incarcerated undocumented aliens who have been incarcerated for at least four (4) consecutive days from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014, and incarcerated on conviction of at least one (1) felony or two (2) misdemeanors. No match is required. (L1227-15)(Gooding/Bastin)
