Authorization to amend the current Agreement with Tyler Technologies that is detailed in Resolution 598-2017. The attached amendment voids an earlier Tyler invoice of \$238,443.67. It also outlines the cost of maintenance upon "go-live" of the new software as well as the maintenance cost of legacy Tyler software already in use by E911 and Lexington Police.
