A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government and pursuant to the Jobs Fund Program, to execute an Incentive Agreement and related documents with Bluegrass Stockyards, LLC, to rebate certain taxes for a period not to exceed ten (10) years or a total amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000), whichever comes first. [Mayor's Office, Atkins]

Authorization to execute an incentive Agreement with the Bluegrass Stockyards to abate certain taxes for a period not to exceed ten (10) years or a total amount of \$1 million, whichever comes first. The Company, which has had a significant historic and economic presence in Fayette County for more than 70 years, is committed to the relocation of its primary operations to a location at 4561 Iron Works Pike, Lexington, Kentucky, Fayette County Kentucky and the Company has committed to the hiring and retention of a minimum of fifty (50) full time and part time employees on the Site for at least the period of time provided in the this Agreement. Taxes will be abated, but no Budgeted funds will be expended. (L0801-16)(Atkins)
