A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute an Amendment to the Agreement with the Fayette County Commonwealth Attorneys' Office, extending the period of performance through June 30, 2019, adding \$20,178 Federal funds and reducing Local matching funds by \$17,452, at no cost to the Urban County Government. [Div. of Police, Weathers]

Authorization to execute an amended agreement with the Fayette County Commonwealth Attorney's Office correcting the period of performance for the Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project and adding \$20,178 of additional federal grant funds while reducing local matching funds by \$17,452 for a net increase of \$2,726. Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute the Amendment to the Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with the Fayette County Commonwealth's

Attorneys' Office, extending the period of performance through June 30, 2019, adding \$20,178.00 Federal funds and reducing Local matching funds by \$17,452.00, at no cost to the Urban County Government.
