An Ordinance amending the Classified Civil Service authorized strength by abolishing two (2) positions of Project Manager Sr., Grade 519E, and creating two (2) positions of Project Manager Sr., Grade 519N, in the Div. of Streets and Roads; transferring the incumbents from exempt to non-exempt positions and converting their biweekly salaries to hourly rates of pay, effective the first payroll Monday following passage of Council. [Div. of Human Resources, Maxwell] Authorization to abolish and create positions in order to conform with the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) and transferring all incumbents from exempt to non-exempt status, effective the first payroll Monday following passage of Council. While base salaries remain the same, there May be a potential fiscal impact due to the fact that these employees become eligible for overtime pay. (L0171-17) (Maxwell/Hamilton)
