Authorization to request approval of Change Order #3 (Final) to the LFUCG Contract with Van Hook Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$10,403.44 for construction services associated with the West Hickman Waste Water Treatment Plant Administrative Building Expansion/Improvements project.
