A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute Change Order No. 4 (Final) to the contract with Todd Johnson Construction, Co., for construction of the Meadows/Northland/Arlington Public Improvements Project, Phase 5A, decreasing the contract price by the sum of \$67,239.76 from \$1,706,616.82 to \$1,639,377.06, and appropriating funds. Authorization to execute change order No. 4 (Final) to reduce the agreement with Todd Johnson Construction Co. in the amount of \$67,239.76 for Meadows/Northland/Arlington Public Improvements Project, Phase 5A. The change order adjusts quantities to those needed for construction of the project. Then new contract total is reduced to \$1,639,377.06. (L0652-15)(Gooding/Paulsen)
