A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute an amendment with Seagrave Fire Apparatus, LLC, for a material cost increase for two custom Fire apparatus units, at a cost not to exceed \$224,998. [Div. of Fire and Emergency Services, Wells]

Authorization to amend the Contract with Seagrave Fire Apparatus, LLC relating to two (2) custom Fire apparatus dated September 7, 2021 (Contract#105-2020) that includes a Material Cost Increase (MCI) of \$224,998 in addition to the original Contracted price of \$1,468,890 for the (2) units. This is a one-time MCI, and no additional MCI will be added to the original order terms. Funds are Budgeted. (L0879-23) (Wells/Armstrong)
