An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by creating one (1) classified position of Intelligence Specialist, Grade 515N, in the Div. of Police; creating one (1) classified position of Implementation Coordinator, Grade 520E, in the Dept. of Social Services; and creating one (1) unclassified position of Information Officer, Grade 518E, with the term date of December 31, 2026, in the Office of the Urban County Council, all effective July 1, 2023.
