A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Bluegrass Area Development District which Grant funds are in the amount of \$123,000 Federal and Commonwealth of Ky. funds, are for the operation of the Lexington Senior Center for FY 2020, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$284,094 as a local match, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a Grant from the Bluegrass Area Development District, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$123,000.00 Federal and Commonwealth of Kentucky funds, are for the operation of the Lexington Senior Center for FY 2020, and the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$284,094.00 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
