A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute Change Order No. 6 to the Contract with Smith Contractors, Inc., for the Town Branch and West Hickman Wastewater Treatment Plant Electrical, SCADA, Blower/Aeration and Pump Station Improvements Project, increasing the contract price by the sum of \$132,472.22 from \$14,665,119.85 to \$14,797,592.07. [Div. of Water Quality, Martin]

Authorization to approve Change Order #6 to Smith Contractors, Inc. for additional work to the Town Branch and West Hickman WWTP Electrical, SCADA, Blower/Aeration and Pump Stations Improvements Project. This change order results in an increase of \$132,472.22 to the contract. The new contract amount is \$14,797,592.07. Funds are fully budgeted. (L1103-15)(Martin/Holmes)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized to execute Change Order No. 6, which is attached hereto and incorporated

herein by reference, to the Contract with Smith Contractors, Inc. for the Town Branch and West Hickman Wastewater Treatment Plant Electrical, SCADA, Blower/Aeration and Pump Station Improvements Project, increasing the contract price by the sum of \$132,472.22 from \$14,665,119.85 to \$14,797,592.07.

Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$132,472.22, be and hereby is approved for payment to Smith Contractors, Inc. from account # 4003-303401-92711 pursuant to the terms of the Change Order.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
