A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept a Grant from the Ky. Transportation Cabinet, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$43,000 Federal funds, are for design of the Town Branch Trail Crossing under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program, the acceptance of which obligates the Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$10,750 as a local match. [Div. of Grants and Special Programs/Dept. of Planning, Preservation and Development, Gooding/Paulsen]

Authorization to accept award of federal funds in the amount of \$43,000 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for design of Town Branch Trail Crossing at Old Frankfort Pike and McConnell Springs Drive under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program. There is a requirement of 20% local match, or \$10,750. A budget amendment is in process. (L0540-15) (Gooding/Paulsen)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY
GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a Grant from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$43,000.00 Federal funds, are for design of the Town Branch Trail Crossing under the Congestion, Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program, and the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$10,750.00 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
